## WOMEN IN STATE LEGISLATURES 2009

In 2009, 1,797, or 24.3% of the 7,382 state legislators in the United States are women. Women currently hold 433, or 22.0%, of the 1,971 state senate seats and 1,364, or 25.2%, of the 5,411 state house or assembly seats. Since 1971, the number of women serving in state legislatures has more than quintupled.

### Women in State Legislative Leadership

Five women serve as presidents of senates: Colleen Hanabusa (D-HI), Elizabeth H. Mitchell (D-ME), Therese Murray (D-MA), Sylvia Larsen (D-NH), and M. Teresa Paiva-Weed (D-RI). Five women serve as speakers of state houses: Karen Bass (D-CA), Hannah Pingree (D-ME), Barbara Buckley (D-NV), Margaret Anderson Kelliher (DFL-MN), and Terie Norelli (D-NH).

## Women of Color in State Legislatures

Of the 1,797 women legislators serving nationwide, **350** or **19.5%** are women of color. They include 101 senators and 249 representatives; 330 are Democrats, 18 are Republicans and two are non-partisans. Women of color constitute 4.7% of the total 7,382 state legislators.

#### The First Women Legislators

In 1894, the first women state legislators were elected to serve in the United States. Three Republican women were elected to the Colorado House of Representatives: Clara Cressingham; Carrie C. Holly; Frances Klock. The first woman state senator, Democrat Martha Hughes Cannon, was elected to the Utah State Senate in 1896.
